POND CONSTRUCTION

People are always fascinated by moving water. The constantly moving shapes have a magic to them that can hardly be explained. Just like fireworks, water displays have always been a part of celebrations. With the right pump, you can create your own individual water feature. The ideal location for a garden pond should be half in shade with 4-6 sunny hours a day.

USING LINER...

Step By Step To How It's Done



First mark out the pond contours with sand.



The different depth zones should also be marked with sand.



Then use string to generously measure the necessary length of the fleece and the pond liner.



After excavating the soil, first line the hole with fleece, to protect against root & rock penetration.



Then carefully lay out the liner.



After gravel and plants are in place, at last it is time to put water in the pond: First fill it half full, then after the liner has settled completely, fill the pond.



The final step is to fill the edge area with rock (pebbles or similar) and landscape it as you desire.



The result deserves to be seen: Living water landscapes with pond construction materials from All-In-One.
